Connecting to Voicemail

1. From your campus phone:

Press 

From another campus phone:

Dial x55100

From an outside line:

Dial 301.405.5100

2. Press star (*)

3. Enter your 5-digit extension

4. Press pound (#)

5. Enter your Voicemail PIN

6. Press pound (#)

Default Voicemail PIN: 20742

(You will set your own PIN the first time you log in.)

After logging in, you can:

Check New Messages — Press 1

Send a Message — Press 2

Review Old Messages — Press 3

Configure Greetings — Press 4, then press 1

Configure Message Settings — Press 4, then press 2

While listening to a message, you can:

Repeat — Press 1

Save — Press 2

Delete — Press 3

Slow Playback — Press 4

Speed Up Playback — Press 6

Skip Back to Previous Message — Press 7

Pause (and Resume) — Press 8

Listen to Message Properties — Press 9

After listening to a message, you can:

Repeat — Press 1

Save — Press 2

Delete — Press 3

Reply — Press 4

Forward — Press 5

Mark as New — Press 6

Skip Back to Previous Message — Press 7

Listen to Message Properties — Press 9
